

**TOWN OF BROOKFIELD
PLAN COMMISSION MINUTES
JULY 26, 2022**

Town Chairman Keith Henderson called the meeting to order at 7:00pm on Tuesday, July 26, 2022, at the Town of Brookfield Town Hall, 645 North Janacek Road, Brookfield, Wisconsin. Also present at the meeting was Supervisor Mike Schmitt; Commissioners Gordon Gaeth, William Neville, Len Smeltzer; Jeremy Watson, and Town Planner Bryce Hembrook. Commissioner Riordan was absent.

CONFIRMATION OF MEETING NOTICE

Town Planner Bryce Hembrook reported that the agenda was noticed and posted as required.

MINUTES – REGULAR MEETING

Commissioner Watson moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting at the June 28, 2022 Plan Commission meeting as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Gaeth and motion carried unanimously.

Discussion and action on establishing the vision statement for the 2022-2042 Town of Brookfield Comprehensive Plan

Town Planner Hembrook presented the proposed values and vision statement for the 2022-2042 Town of Brookfield Comprehensive Plan. Town Chairman Henderson provided three options to consider for the vision statement and the Commission discussed and agreed on option 1. Option 1 stated “The Town of Brookfield is a community where a family can enjoy the benefits of a small town that provides the services of larger municipalities, at a small-town price”.

The Commission then discussed the Brookfield’s Values and Vision section and decided to include the following in the Comprehensive Plan:

- We value our unique identity
- We value our strong sense of community
- We value our community where we can work, play, and gather
- We value our businesses
- We value of suburban feel
- We value our high quality of living with low taxes.

Town Planner Hembrook mentioned that he will include these recommendations in the Comprehensive Plan and will send draft chapters 1-4 for the next Plan Commission meeting.
