### Learn to Speed Skate

The Learn to Speed Skate program teaches students progressively more difficult moves through six levels of skating. Prerequisites for taking the class include knowing how to get up after falling down, marching forward, stopping, swizzles, and two-foot glide. Students are evaluated at the first class session to gauge their skill/ability level and are placed in another speed skating class if their skill level is applicable. Rental is \$3.50/time. \*\*20 Min of Exclusive Practice Time Follows Each Class Time.

### Spring Learn To Ice Skate - NEW!!!

Skate rental is also included in the price of the class. Please arrive 10 minutes early to put skates on.
