

Town of Brookfield Comprehensive Plan Open House

The Town of Brookfield is currently in the process of creating a Comprehensive Plan and will host an open house at Brookfield Town Hall, located at 645 Janacek Road, starting at 6pm. The proposed Town of Brookfield 2022-2042 Comprehensive Plan will be presented to the public. Following the open house, starting at 7pm, the Town of Brookfield Plan Commission will hold a public hearing to consider public comments regarding the proposed Comprehensive Plan. All persons interested in learning about the proposed plan are encouraged to attend.

The primary reason for creating this comprehensive plan is to identify a shared vision among the community's residents, elected officials, and municipal staff. A comprehensive plan identifies a community's priorities and provides a comprehensive and integrated set of recommendations to guide the development and redevelopment of the Town. Recommendations were developed from ideas and feedback provided by community residents and leaders through a public survey and workshop.

The Town of Brookfield's Plan Commission has worked closely with planning consultants from SEH in creating this document and is requesting feedback from the public. The plan will provide policy recommendations for the following topics: housing, transportation, utilities and community facilities, natural and cultural resources, economic development, intergovernmental cooperation, and land use.
