- 1. Call to Order.
 - The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.
 - Town Board Membership Present: Chairman Keith Henderson, Supervisors Steve Kohlmann, Ryan Stanelle, John Charlie's, and John Schatzman. Absent: None. A quorum was met (5-0).
 - The meeting was staffed by Administrator Tom Hagie, Clerk Deanna Alexander, Planner Bryce Hembrook, and Attorney Michael Van Kleunen.
- 2. Meeting Notices: The Clerk confirmed the meeting was publicly noticed.
- 3. Adoption of the Agenda.
 - Motion by Schatzman to approve the agenda; seconded by Stanelle. Motion prevailed by a voice vote, (5-0).
- 4. Approval of Minutes: February 20, 2024 TB, UD1, SD4 Meeting.
 - It was noted that the minutes should distinguish between the two votes for minutes approval to show that one vote was for each of two portions of the minutes.
 - Motion by Stanelle to approve the minutes with the noted change; seconded by Kohlmann. The motion prevailed by a voice vote (5-0).
- 5. Citizen Comments. Three minute limit.
 - No members of the public requested to be heard.

Old Business: None.

New Business: None.

Departments, Boards, Committee / Commission Reports and Recommendations:

8. Plan Commission: A Recommendation for Final Approval of a New Building Consisting of a Three-Story Salon Suite Facility, Located at 21055 Crossroad Circle.

Ryan Janssen appearing, representing Avery & Birch.

- The Town Planner presented an overview. The developer sought to show they want to divide the lot and showed how the lot size and shape of the resulting parcels would continue to meet zoning requirements. The Architectural Review Committee and Plan Commission have both recommended approval.
- The Chairman noted that the Plan Commission had a concern about the height of the building being
 the same height as the nearby trees, so there may be some unwanted visibility between the houses
 and the building.
- Schatzman stated that he thought that whenever there are signs or lighting for a new building, they are supposed to be included in the plans. The Attorney opined that the code is not presently written in a way that requires sign information to be included in the package for final approvals, so an applicant can

- bifurcate the process and seek separate sign approval on its own application. Schatzman asked if the landscape bond had been considered and asked for a non-annexation agreement.
- Kohlmann stated that he dislikes the design of the building.
- Motion by Schatzman to approve, contingent upon a storm water maintenance agreement, nonannexation agreement, signs to come back to board for approval prior to installation, and town engineer approval, seconded by Stanelle. Motion prevailed by a voice vote of
- Motion prevailed on a voice vote (4-1). No: Kohlmann.
- 9. Fire Department: Fire Chief Job Description Approval.
 - Members discussed whether to include or exclude certain language about criminal records versus criminal convictions, and language about being a "Citizen of the United States in good standing."
 The board made consensus to eliminate "in good standing" and the portion about the criminal record; and to add noting that there will be a Town phone provided.
 - Motion by Charlier to approve the Fire Chief Job Description as advised for amending; seconded by Kohlmann. Motion prevailed by a voice vote, (5-0).
- Treasury: Review of Vouchers and Checks.
 Motion by Kohlmann to approve the vouchers and checks as presented for \$215,026.87; seconded by Charlier.
 Motion prevailed by a voice vote, (5-0).
- 12. Communications and Announcements.
 - Chair discussed request to WTA to get money for roads, putting out Davidson Road, in two projects, one west of Barker and one east of Barker; and neighboring municipalities would join in the project.
 We were rated the number one project in the district. There's a 70% split, where the Town would still have to cover 30% of it. Out of 342 projects ranked, Town of Brookfield came out #1.
 - Reminder of Easter Egg Hunt on March 30th.
 - Administrator announced 20-year Carol White celebration at Town Hall next Thursday.
 - Administrator announced that on May 22nd there is a WISDOT Hwy59 informational meeting.
 - The Clerk asked about minutes and the Board members' comfort level with the detail level.
 - Charlier asked what the state is doing around Doral Rd. Administrator responded its fiber installation.
 - Kohlmann asked if there was any discussion with the Waukesha highway department about the
 potholes at Barker & Bluemound. The Administrator responded no. He also asked if there was any
 update on the Master Z's sign, and Don & Roy's sign. The Attorney and Administrator said there
 seems to be an application forthcoming. Kohlmann asked for it to be a discussion item for a future
 meeting.
 - Stanelle noted that right at the end of the Melting Pot, there were some cold packs put in and there are some significant holes there. The Administrator stated that the Town is no longer involved in that maintenance and he can send a friendly letter recognizing the needed maintenance.
- 13. Adjourn.
 - Motion at 7:45pm by Charlier to adjourn; seconded by Kohlmann. Motion prevailed by a voice vote of (5-0).

6.5. GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK:

- a. The MUNICIPALITY shall deliver to the SITE, Yard Waste and Wood Waste that is collected by the MUNICIPALITY or from residents of the MUNICIPALITY, whether such collection is at a drop-off site, through curb-side collection, or some other method, and all Yard Waste and Wood Waste that is generated by the MUNICIPALITY itself through any of its park, road or other governmental operations.
- b. Wood Waste shall be delivered separately from Yard Waste.
- c. Delivery times and dates shall be coordinated between the MUNICIPALITY or its contracted hauler and the CONTRACTOR. The CONTRACTOR will accept deliveries during (hours and days): 7:00AM -5:00 PM Monday-Saturday
- d. The CONTRACTOR will provide a website for entering dumping tickets electronically. Driver's will need to enter Hauler Name, Municipality, Load Size, Load Type, Approximate Volume in Yards, Driver Name, Truck Number, and certify that they have inspected the load to verify it doesn't contain any contaminated material. Drivers/Haulers who do not use the electronic ticketing system will not be allowed to dump.

7.6. RECORD KEEPING AND REPORTS:

- a. The Contractor must keep adequate monthly records and submit invoices to the contracted municipality. The Contractor must submit annual reports to the County, which will be used for annual reporting. The annual reports shall be submitted electronically through e-mail to the MUNICIPALITY, and shall include the following minimum information:
 - i. Number of loads of all yard and wood wastes, delivered to the SITE, including truck numbers, date, time, truck type and type of waste for each delivery.
 - ii. Records of any rejected load, including the reasons for the rejection and the source of the material.

8.7. PROCESSING FEE:

- a. For each load of Yard Waste delivered to the SITE by the MUNICIPALITY, the MUNICIPALITY shall pay the CONTRACTOR \$114 per load less than 20 yards and \$144 per load equal to or larger than 20 yards. Commencing with January 1, 2025, and for each contract year thereafter, this per yard payment shall be adjusted based upon the Consumer Price Index Urban for the previous July, with no increase to exceed 10% of the previous per yard amount.
- b. For each load of Wood Waste delivered to the SITE by the MUNICIPALITY, the MUNICIPALITY shall pay the CONTRACTOR \$114 per load less than 20 yards and \$144 per load equal to or larger than 20 yards. Commencing with January 1, 2025, and for each contract year thereafter, this per yard payment shall be adjusted based upon the Consumer Price Index Urban for the previous July, with no increase to exceed 10% of the previous per yard amount.
- c. Payment shall be made by the MUNICIPALITY on a monthly basis, on or about the 20th day of each month for all loads received by the MUNICIPALITY during the previous month.
- d. Except as provided in Sections 3 and 4, 4 of a MUNICIPALITY delivers anything to the SITE that is not Yard Waste or Wood Waste, the delivery shall be rejected by the CONTRACTOR and

any such items or material shall be removed from the SITE by the CONTRACTOR. Stumps with intact root balls are specifically excluded from the definitions of Yard Waste and Wood Waste and shall not be delivered to the SITE. The presence of glass, metal, plastic, or any "trash" in addition to hazardous waste containers in a delivery, or the presence of unusual colors, chemicals or odors in a delivery, shall be cause for rejection of the delivery. Removal will be completed by the CONTRACTOR and paid by the MUNCIPALITY.

- e. For removal and disposal of any unacceptable materials, MUNICIPALITY shall pay the CONTRACTOR \$250 plus the additional cost of CONTRACTOR'S time required to remove and properly dispose of it.
- f. For relocation of material dumped in the incorrect location, MUNICIPALITY shall pay the CONTRACTOR \$250 plus \$250 each additional hour to relocate the material.
- g. For repairing any damage caused by MUNICIPALITY'S hauler (i.e. driving into areas roped off and creating work to regrade), MUNICIPALITY shall pay the CONTRACTOR \$250 per hour to repair any damage caused by haulers to the SITE.

9.8. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. The CONTRACTOR shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, ordinances, codes, and rules and any permits applicable to processing recyclable materials.
- b. This CONTRACT may not be assigned by the CONTRACTOR without the prior written consent of the MUNICIPALITY.
- c. Neither the MUNICIPALITY nor the CONTRACTOR shall have any responsibility to perform services for or to assume obligations which are the obligation of the other Party. The CONTRACTOR agrees that it is an independent entity with respect to the services provided pursuant to this CONTRACT. Nothing in this CONTRACT shall be considered to create the relationship of employer and employee between the Parties or their respective employees.
- d. Unless otherwise specifically provided by the terms of this CONTRACT, no delay or failure to exercise a right or to declare any breach of this CONTRACT shall impair the right or shall be construed to be a waiver of a default, but the right may be exercised from time to time and as often as may be deemed expedient. Any waiver shall be in writing and signed by the Party granting the waiver. If any representation, warranty or covenant contained in this CONTRACT is breached by either Party and waived by the other Party, the waiver shall be limited to the particular breach waived and shall not be deemed to waive any other breach under this CONTRACT. One or more waivers by any Party of any term of this CONTRACT will not be construed as a waiver of a subsequent breach of the same or any other term. The consent or approval given by any Party with respect to any act by the other Party requiring such consent or approval shall not be deemed to waive the need for further consent or approval of any subsequent act by such Party.
- e. No amendment, modification, change or extension of this CONTRACT shall be effective unless it is in writing and executed by the Parties.
- f. In the event that any provision of this CONTRACT in any respect shall, for any reason, be determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the other terms of this CONTRACT shall remain in full force and effect and be construed in such a manner as to implement and give effect to the intentions of the Parties as reflected in the

- CONTRACT. To the extent necessary to have such effect, the Parties shall negotiate in good faith for necessary amendments, modifications, or supplements of or to this CONTRACT.
- g. In connection with the performance of work under this CONTRACT, the CONTRACTOR agrees not to discriminate against any employee, applicant for employment, or actual or potential recipients of services because of sex, race, religion, color, national origin or ancestry, age, disability, lawful source of income, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, past or present membership in the military service, familial status, or based upon affiliation with, or perceived affiliation with, any of these protected categories. This provision shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The CONTRACTOR agrees to post in conspicuous places, available for employees and applicants for employment, notices setting forth the provisions of the non-discrimination clause.
- h. Disputes by either party as to the applicability of this CONTRACT's provisions including quality or content of delivered materials, non-recyclable residues, recordkeeping or the accuracy of applicable determinations or calculations, shall require notice to the other party in writing (notice via electronic mail is acceptable if acknowledged and accepted by other party). Parties shall make best efforts to resolve such disputes within ten (10) business days. If not resolved, either party may seek such other redress as may be available, including mediation of such dispute if acceptable to both parties.
- i. If a party is unable, in whole or in part, to punctually carry out its obligations under this CONTRACT because of a Force Majeure Event, such party's obligations, to the extent affected thereby, will be extended on a day-by-day basis during the continuance of the delay caused by such event. The party claiming the Force Majeure Event shall use reasonable efforts to remedy such Force Majeure Event as promptly as commercially practicable after such event occurs and at the time that it is no longer applicable. The party affected by the Force Majeure Event shall give the other party notice as soon as commercially practicable (but not later than 15 working days) after such event occurs, at 30-day intervals during any continuation of such incident, and at the time that it is no longer applicable. Notice shall state with particularity the nature of the claimed event and provide a reasonable estimate of the length of any delay in the fulfillment of obligations under this CONTRACT. If a Force Majeure Event lasts for more than 60 calendar days, the party not claiming the Force Majeure Event may terminate this CONTRACT immediately upon providing written notice to the other party. "Force Majeure Event" means the occurrence of an act of God; unusual governmental restrictions, regulation or control, (through no fault of a party); war, riot, fire, drought, flood, explosion, natural disaster, national emergency, or other circumstances, whether or not similar in nature, beyond the reasonable control of the party seeking to be excused from performance hereunder; provided, however, economic conditions do not constitute a Force Majeure Event and a Force Majeure Event will not relieve a party of its payment obligations.
- j. This CONTRACT constitutes the entire CONTRACT between the parties. No modification, amendment, alteration, revision, or waiver of this CONTRACT or any of its provisions shall be permitted by or binding upon the parties unless so agreed in writing.

- <u>10.9.</u> <u>CONTRACTOR</u> CANCELLATION: This CONTRACT may be terminated by <u>either partyCONTRACTOR</u> with a 90-day written notice by either party.
- 11.10. INDEMNIFICATION: The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend MUNICIPALITY, its officers, agents, and employees from and against any and all liabilities, claims, penalties, fines, forfeitures, suits and other costs and expenses incident thereto (including cost of defense, settlement, and reasonable attorney's fees) which may be alleged against MUNICIPALITY or which the MUNICIPALITY may incur, become responsible for, or pay out as a result of death or bodily injury to any person, destruction or damage to any property, contamination of or adverse effects on the environment, or any violation or alleged violation of governmental laws, regulations or orders, to the extent that such damage, injury, contamination or violation was caused by acts, errors or omissions of the CONTRACTOR. The indemnification clause shall not apply in the event of sole negligence by MUNICIPALITY officers, agents and employees.
- 12.11. INSURANCE: The CONTRACTOR agrees that it will, at all times during the Term, keep in force and effect insurance policies, at its own cost and expense, issued by a company or companies authorized to do business in the State of Wisconsin and satisfactory to the County and Municipality. Such insurance shall be primary, and all insurers must be rated A-VIII or better by A.M. Best. The insurer must be satisfactory to the MUNICIPALITY. The CONTRACTOR shall maintain the following insurance policies at all times during the Term:

- 13.12. TERMINATION: The MUNICIPALITY may terminate this CONTRACT at any time if, in the opinion of the MUNICIPALITY, the CONTRACTOR is not performing in a satisfactory manner. The MUNICIPALITY will give the CONTRACTOR thirty (30) days' advance written notice of the termination. In the event of any such termination, the CONTRACTOR waives any right or remedy against the MUNICIPALITY.
- 14.13. JURISDICTION/VENUE: The circuit court of Waukesha County, Wisconsin, shall have exclusive jurisdiction and venue for any legal proceedings concerning this CONTRACT, and CONTRACTOR and MUNICIPALITY submit to the jurisdiction of the Waukesha County Circuit Court for such proceedings. All such proceedings shall be governed by the laws of the State of Wisconsin.
- <u>15.14.</u> SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this CONTRACT is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of the CONTRACT shall remain valid and in full force and effect. The invalid provision shall be replaced by a valid provision that comes closest in intent to the invalid provision.
- 16.15. NOTICES: Notices required by this CONTRACT shall be in writing and delivered via mail (postage prepaid), commercial courier, or personal delivery and sent by email. Any notice delivered or sent as aforesaid shall be effective on the date of delivery or sending. All notices and other written communications under this CONTRACT shall be addressed to the individuals in the capacities indicated below, unless otherwise modified by subsequent written notice.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD TO VACATE AND DISCONTINUE A PORTION OF BLUEMOUND FRONTAGE ROAD

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BROOKFIELD, WAUKESHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.1003, the Town Board has statutory authority to vacate and discontinue Town right-of-way within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the public interest requires vacation of an public right-of-way as depicted and described on Exhibit 1, as this is a segment of public way that has no utility and the land can be used by the abutting owners;

WHEREAS, this Resolution was introduced in this form before the Town Board of the Town of Brookfield on February 6, 2024;

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing stating when and where this Resolution would be acted upon and stating what public way is proposed to be discontinued was published as a Class 3 Notice under Chapter 985, Wisconsin Statutes, and in addition was served on the owners of all of the frontage of the lots and lands abutting upon the public way sought to be discontinued (said properties as described in Exhibit 2) in a manner provided for the service of Summons in Circuit Court at least 30 days before the hearing;

WHEREAS, no written objections to the proposed discontinuance have been filed with the Town Clerk by any of the owners abutting on the public way sought to be discontinued, or by the owners of more than one-third of the frontage of the lots or lands abutting on the remainder of the public way which lies within 2,650 feet from the ends of the public way proposed to be discontinued or which lies within that portion of the 2,650 feet that is within the Town limits; or if such objection has been filed, two-thirds of the members of the Town Board voting on the proposed discontinuance have voted in favor of the discontinuance;

WHEREAS, following introduction of this Resolution, a copy of this Resolution was delivered to the Secretary of Transportation as the public way to be discontinued is located within one-quarter mile of a state trunk highway or connecting highway;

WHEREAS, no landlocked parcel will be created by the proposed discontinuance;

WHEREAS, the owners of all of the lands abutting the right-of-way have submitted, or will submit prior to this Resolution taking effect, a certified survey map for approval under Chapter 236 of the Wisconsin Statutes, which will establish the new boundaries of the abutting parcels, including the revision of title as to vacated public way, and further provide an easement for the real property located at 18880 W Bluemound Road (Tax Key No.: BKFT1124999004) to access the portion of the Bluemound Frontage that will remain a public way;

WHEREAS, the Town Board has conducted such public hearing on _______, 2024, pursuant to such notice; and

WHEREAS, following due consideration of all information received from Owners, the Town Engineer, and in the course of the public hearing of this matter and being duly advised, the Town Board, by this Resolution, does hereby declare the public interest requires the vacation and discontinuance of the public way as specifically described and identified on Exhibit 1, and the Town Board further finds that the vacation and discontinuance of the public way will not land lock any property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Brookfield, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, that the public way depicted on the attached Exhibit 1 is hereby discontinued pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.1003, subject to approval and delivery to the Town Clerk for recording, and recording with the Waukesha County Register Deeds, Wisconsin of a certified survey map which will establish the new boundaries of the abutting parcels, including the revision of title as to vacated public way, and further provide an easement for the real property located at 18880 W Bluemound Road (Tax Key No.: BKFT1124999004) to access the portion of the Bluemound Frontage that will remain a public way;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receipt by the Town of the original certified survey map bearing approval of all necessary governmental bodies and parties-in-interest, the Town Clerk shall record a certified copy of this Resolution together with said certified survey map with the Waukesha County Register of Deeds.







<u>SECTION 2:</u> All other provisions of the Town Code, including Sections 5.23(1)(b)–(f), shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 3:</u> All ordinances or parts of this Ordinance conflicting or contravening the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 4:</u> This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
